



PROPOSAL: ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMUNITY HEALTH FACILITY FOR ONG'ICHA SOCCER ACADEMY (OSA-KENYA)

1. Introduction

Currently, OSA-Kenya lacks an on-site health facility, making it difficult to address injuries, illnesses, and routine health needs. This project aims to establish a modern community health facility that provides accessible, affordable, and quality healthcare services for children, their families, and the wider community.

2. Project Goal

To construct and operate a fully functional health facility within OSA-Kenya premises that ensures timely medical attention, promotes community health awareness, and enhances overall well-being of children and families in the Ong'icha Community.

- To establish emergency care and injury management for academy players.
